

The Domaine

Rosily Vineyard is situated on Yelverton Road in the Wilyabrup sub region of Margaret River. The total vineyard size is 12.27 hectares. The Cabernet Sauvignon 2016 harvest represents 12.8% of the total vintage. Only fruit from this vineyard is used in the production of our wines. The wines are all made at the winery constructed on the property in the year 2000.

The most elevated section of our single vineyard site has some large gravel components in the soils, which is crucial for the consistent production of premium cabernet sauvignon fruit.

Tasting Notes

Appearance: Clear, bright, deep red / purple with a crimson hue.

Strong varietal definition including fresh red currant, Nose:

cedar and bay leaf.

Palate: Medium to full-bodied wine with typical sub district blackberry, olive,

mint and cassis characters. A dried herb finish is well supported by fine

grainy tannins and oak.
