Sub region – Wilyabrup



The Domaine	Rosily Vineyard is situated on Yelverton Road in one of the premier sub districts in Margaret River - Wilyabrup. The total vineyard size is 12.28 hectares. Only fruit from our vineyard is used in the production of our wines. The wines are all made at the winery constructed on the property in the year 2000.
Background	This is the 2nd Pinot Blanc release from Rosily Vineyard. This old-world variety has been blended with our chardonnay wines for a number of years. Given the Pinot Blanc vines have now matured sufficiently has ensured we can showcase this wine as a stand-alone expression. Our major aim each vintage continues to be to display our single vineyard site's possibilities.
Notes	<p>Bottling date – 13th November 2025</p> <p>Production – 2 barrels only.</p> <p>Cropping level – 0.81 tonnes</p> <p>Vineyard - There are a total of 367 Pinot Blanc vines at Rosily Vineyard. The vines were planted as Semillon cuttings in 2009, and subsequently grafted to Pinot Blanc.</p> <p>Appearance - Pale with a slight green hue, yet brilliantly bright.</p> <p>Nose - Displays delicate floral and green apple notes.</p> <p>Palate – Subtle stone fruit flavours with white blossom and pear notes. Given the use of older oak (3 year old French) barrels ensures a gentle textural palate.</p>
Organics	<p>The reasons that grape growers decide to "go organic" are many and varied, but for Rosily Vineyard the decision was made as a result of our commitment to make wines that truly reflect the unique patch of land upon which they are grown, and to look after that land, and the people who work upon it.</p> <p>Having the recognised auditors at Australian Certified Organic go through every step of the growing process each year, from pruning through to harvest, to certify that each step and every input adheres to organic principles, gives us complete integrity and prevents any shortcuts or exceptions being taken.</p>
